ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On September 18, 2009, Randy Coleman Sr. (complainant) filed a complaint against The East Ohio Gas Company, d/b/a Dominion East Ohio (Dominion) and Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. d/b/a IGS Energy (IGS), alleging that Dominion and IGS failed to correctly bill him for natural gas used at a property occupied by the complainant. Specifically, the complainant alleged that either Dominion, IGS, or both, changed his natural gas supplier from Dominion to IGS without his consent.
- (2) On October 14, 2009, both Dominion and IGS filed their answers to the complaint, denying the material allegations in the complaint. Dominion also filed a motion to dismiss stating that it has complied with its obligation to give the complainant an opportunity to rescind his enrollment with IGS and that the complainant did not set forth reasonable grounds for complaint.
- (3) On March 4, 2010, complainant, IGS and Dominion filed a joint motion to dismiss the matter. In the joint motion, the parties request that the Commission dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, as the parties have resolved all issues.
- (4) By entry issued March 5, 2010, the hearing scheduled for March 9, 2010, was held in abeyance pending consideration of the parties' motion to dismiss.

- (5) The Commission finds that the parties' request to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is reasonable and should be granted.


It is, therefore,
