Honorable Attorney Examiners Pirik and Stenman:

Please accept this correspondence in response to the February 9, 2010 Entry in this case, which directed Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke Energy Ohio) to inform the Commission as to whether all of the issues raised in the comments in this case had been resolved.

Comments were filed by the Commission Staff, the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC), and The Kroger Company (Kroger).

Representatives from Duke Energy Ohio, the Commission Staff, the OCC, and Kroger discussed the comments on March 9 and March 24, 2010. All of the issues raised in the comments of the Commission Staff and Kroger have been resolved. Despite the production of substantial information to and discussions with the OCC, Duke Energy Ohio hereby advises that it appears unlikely that all of the issues raised in OCC's comments will be informally resolved. Accordingly, Duke Energy Ohio respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing as soon as practicable.

Duke Energy Ohio believes that an expedited hearing date is appropriate as the Commission authorized carrying charges on the deferred amount. As described in Duke Energy Ohio's Application and the testimony filed contemporaneously therewith, carrying charges are accruing at approximately \$160,000 per month. Furthermore, as the OCC has already engaged in significant discovery, an expedited hearing date should not prejudice the preparations for hearing. Duke Energy Ohio can be prepared to file supplemental direct testimony as early as April 8, 2010.
