The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) On March 12, 2010, Tiger Natural Gas, Inc. (Tiger) filed an application for certification as a competitive retail natural gas provider.
- (2) In accordance with Section 4929.20, Revised Code, and Rule 4901:1-27-06, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), Tiger's certification application is subject to a 30-day automatic approval process. Rule 4901:1-27-06, O.A.C., further provides that, upon good cause shown, the Commission or an attorney examiner may suspend consideration of a certificate application. If an application for certification is suspended, the Commission shall act to approve or deny the application within 90 days of the suspension.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that good cause exists to suspend the 30-day automatic approval process for Tiger's application for certification in order for the Commission and its staff to further review this matter.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the automatic approval process for the application of Tiger for certification as a competitive retail natural gas provider be suspended. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record in this case.


