

MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF
ORMET PRIMARY ALUMINUM CORPORATION'S MOTION TO INTERVENE

Ormet Primary Aluminum Corporation ("Ormet") should be permitted to intervene in these matters pursuant to Section 4903.221, Ohio Revised Code and the Commission's Rules and Regulations contained in Section 4901-1-11 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Ormet is a large industrial retail customer of Columbus Southern Power Company and Ohio Power Company (collectively "AEP Ohio") under a reasonable arrangement with AEP Ohio. As a large industrial customer, Ormet is interested in participating in demand response programs in the future, and therefore has an interest in the design of those programs. In addition, due to the structure of Ormet's reasonable arrangement with AEP Ohio, it is possible that an increase in the Energy Efficiency/Peak Demand Rider such as that contemplated in AEP Ohio's proposal could increase the rate Ormet pays for power from AEP Ohio.

Under Section 4903.221, any person who may be adversely affected by a Commission proceeding may intervene in such proceeding. The Commission's rules state that any person shall be permitted to intervene in a proceeding upon a showing that:

The person has a real and substantial interest in the proceeding, and the person is so situated that the disposition of the proceeding may, as a practical matter, impair or

impede his or her ability to protect that interest, unless the person's interest is adequately represented by existing parties.¹


In deciding whether to permit intervention under Section 4901-1-11(B), the Commission considers:

- (1) The nature and extent of the prospective intervenor's interest.
- (2) The legal position advanced by the prospective intervenor and its probable relation to the merits of the case.
- (3) Whether the intervention by the prospective intervenor will unduly prolong or delay the proceedings.
- (4) Whether the prospective intervenor will significantly contribute to the full development and equitable resolution of the factual issues.
- (5) The extent to which the person's interest is represented by existing parties.

Ormet has a real and substantial interest in these proceedings. Both Ormet's interest in participating in demand response programs and its rates may be impacted by these proceedings and no other party can adequately represent Ormet's interest. Ormet's intervention is timely and will not unduly prolong or delay the proceedings.

WHEREFORE, Ormet respectfully requests that the Commission grant its motion to intervene in these proceedings.






