## **Project Overview:**

After reviewing the Self Direct Prescriptive projects requested incentive and the attached scope of work, we were able to determine that the project being applied for was the retrofit of:

- 1394 T12 to T8 conversions
- 638 T12 delampings
- 95 kW of lighting placed on occupancy sensors
- 52 kW reduction due to HID to T8/T5 conversion

The invoicing that was provided proved the quantities that were applied for were installed. There were also labor quotes and check stubs to provide proof of purchase of the lighting system. The lamps that were installed meet all the current energy savings requirements. It should be noted that the 304 CFL purchases were not backed up by invoices, and additional kW and kWh reductions due to HID conversions are not prescriptive, but may be submitted as custom projects.
