Notes: Exactly 3 years ago, we purchased the above all-electric home with a budgeted amount of \$175.00 per month. This was a budget based on only radiant heat, no air conditioning. Running a couple of window units the following summer raised the budget to \$195. The year after that, \$235. Based usage, the \$235 budget amount comes up approximately \$1500 short! If this gets calculated into the next budget year, my electric bill budget will become \$360/month - more than double in three years. Homes in Avon Lake took about a 15% hit in value due to the economic disaster. With an electric bill as described, these homes may not even be salable at any price. I am absolutely opposed to the elimination of the Residential Distribution Credit being discussed on case 09-906-3L-SSO
