FIRST ENERGY IS ALSO WANTING THE CONSUMER TO PAY FOR THEIR BUSINESS DECISION TO MOVE THEIR TRANSMISSION ASSETS. IS THERE NO END

TO FIRST ENERGY'S ATTEMPT TO INCREASE REVENUE
FOR THEIR SHAREHOLDERS BY GOUGING THE AVERAGE
CUSTOMER LIKE ME?

I PRAY THAT THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION
OF OHIO TAKES IN ALL CONTRIBUTING FACTORS IN
