This office has recently received a safety complaint against Wheeling and Lake Erie Railroad, a common rail carrier with rail yard terminal located at 2800 Gambrinus Avenue, Canton, Ohio.

More specifically, walking conditions in said yard, tracks five(5) thru fifteen (15) have been reported as unsafe due to debris, big rocks, wood and metal lying in the walking area where workers must walk during performance of there duties.

The employees working in Gambrinus Yard have complained about this situation, but the condition has not been corrected.

I ask that PUCO investigate this workplace, and if deemed to pose an unsafe working condition, require Wheeling and Lake Erie to remove theses track from active service until the condition has been corrected.
