Please find enclosed on behalf of T-NETIX Telecommunications Services, Inc. ("T-NETIX") an original and ten copies of proposed revisions to the Company's Tariff PUCO No. 1. Pages affected by this filing include: Twelfth Revised Sheet No. 2, First Revised Sheet No. 18.1 and Third Revised Sheet No. 23.3. T-NETIX has also enclosed the Telecommunications Application Form indicating these tariff revisions as a TRF filing with the required Exhibits "A" through "C".

The purpose of the proposed revisions is to do the following: 1) Introduce the Wireless Administration Fee as described in Section 3.5.2. Please note that this fee only effects customers adding wireless telephone numbers to their prepaid accounts going forward or opening a new prepaid account using a wireless telephone number. As such the Wireless Administration Fee will have no immediate effect on existing customers including those with existing wireless numbers included on their prepaid accounts. 2) T-NETIX is also tariffing a Credit Card/Check-by-Phone Payment Processing Fee. T-NETIX respectfully requests an effective date of May 11, 2010 for this filing.

The purpose of the proposed revisions is to do the following: 1) Introduce the Wireless Administration Fee as described in Section 3.5.2. 2) T-NETIX is also tariffing a Credit Card/Check-by-Phone Payment Processing Fee.
