- (1) On March 17, 2010, Endeavor Solar Farm (Endeavor) filed an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility.
- (2) Pursuant 4901:1-40-04(F)(2), Rule Ohio to Administrative Code, this application is subject to a 60-day automatic approval process. The rule also provides that the Commission may suspend an application during the 60-day approval process.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that additional information and investigation is necessary to thoroughly review this application. Therefore, good cause exists to suspend the 60-day automatic approval process for Endeavor's application for certification, in order for the Commission and its staff to further review these matters.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the automatic approval process for the application of Endeavor for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility be suspended. It is, further,
