Revised tariff sheets have been filed with the FCC to amend Verizon Tariff FCC No. 14, Facilities for Interstate Access, in which Verizon North Inc. concurs for intrastate applications.

Transmittal No. 1086— Effective May 22, 2010

With this transmittal, Verizon is revising FCC No. 14 to remove the Washington Interagency Telecommunications System 2001 (WITS 2001). WITS 2001 was grandfathered to existing customers on January 22, 2008 under Transmittal No. 888. There are currently no customers purchasing WITS 2001 under the existing tariffs.

The actual filing documents may be viewed on the FCC's Internet website — www.fcc.gov — by doing the following:

1. On the FCC's main page www.fcc.gov at the top of the page, next to the FCC login, you will find a horizontal list of options. Click on E-Filing.

6. On the next page, click on "Verizon Telephone Companies."
7. On the next page, click on "FCC14". However, before moving to the next page, you may want to bookmark this page in order to skip Steps 1-6 in the future.
8. On the next page, you will be shown a table of the filings that have been made for that tariff number starting with the most recent. Click on the part of the filing you want to view under the heading "View PDF". Each filing may have several parts, so look for the transmittal number on each line.

1. **With this filing, Verizon removes the Washington Interagency Telecommunications System 2001 (WITS 2001) from Tariff FCC Nos. 1, 14 and 20. WITS 2001 was grandfathered to existing customers on January 22, 2008 under Transmittal No. 888. There are currently no customers purchasing WITS 2001 under these tariffs.**

Supporting material as specified under Section 61.38 of the Commission's rules is not required for this portion of the filing.

2. **With this filing, Verizon removes Exchange Access Switched Multi-Megabit Data Service (SMDS) from Tariff FCC Nos. 1 and 20 and a related reference from Tariff FCC No. 11. SMDS was grandfathered to existing customers on January 1, 2002 under Transmittal No. 131. There are currently no customers purchasing SMDS under these tariffs.**

Supporting material as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commission's rules is not required for this portion of the filing. There was no Price Cap base period demand for SMDS in the Price Cap Indices filed in the 2009 Annual Filing. Therefore, there is no impact on any of the Price Cap indices. All the elements will be removed from the Price Cap detail with the next filing requiring Price Cap support.

3. **With this filing, Verizon removes an obsolete general regulation and two expired promotions from Tariff FCC No. 20. Verizon also updates certain technical publication information in Tariff FCC No. 1.**

Supporting material as specified under the Commission's rules is not required for this portion of the filing.
