- 3. Emergency Line Service does not provide access to calling within the customer's local calling scope, except as noted above.
- 4. Emergency Line Service allows the customer to receive incoming calls.
- 5. Lines equipped with Emergency Line Service will not have a directory listing, nor will other calling features be available.
- 6. This Service can only be used in conjunction with the Company's HSI Essentials Package.

B. RATES

- 1. The Emergency Line Service rate will equal 50% of the applicable monthly basic service rate as contained in Section 4 of this Tariff.
- 2. All relevant taxes and surcharges will apply.
- 3. All relevant service charges, connection fees, and other non-recurring charges will apply. (N)

The Applicant, The Germantown Independent Telephone Company, hereby adds a new service, Emergency Line Service, to its tariff. Emergency Line Service is only available as a component of a new bundled service package, HSI Essentials, which is also being added to the tariff with this Application. Emergency Line Service allows customers to subscribe to a high-speed Internet service, while retaining an access line at 50% of the basic local exchange access line rate. This new service is designed for customers who want High Speed Internet access service without traditional voice service, but who also desire the reliability of wireline-based E911 access.
