- (1) On August 12, 1999, Time Warner Telecom of Ohio, L.P., ICG Telecom Group, Inc., CoreComm, Newco Inc., and the Telecommunications Resellers Association filed a petition seeking to initiate a generic investigation of the treatment of reciprocal compensation for internet service provider (ISP) traffic.
