The Commission finds:


- (1) On April 14, 2010, Microman, Inc. (Microman or complainant) filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio (AT&T). In the complaint, Microman alleges that AT&T failed to install a telecommunications line and improperly billed for its services.
- (2) On May 5, 2010, AT&T filed an answer in which it denied all material allegations of the complaint.
- (3) On May 20, 2010, Microman filed a motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice. In its supporting memorandum, Microman explains that the complaint has been settled.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, pursuant to the complainant's motion to dismiss, the complaint in this matter be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.




