Re: Request for Re-Negotiation of the Interconnection Agreement
between Telephone Service Company and Sprint Communications Company L.P.
("Agreement")

Dear Mr. Pedersen:

This letter serves as a request to re-negotiate the above-referenced Interconnection Agreement for the State of Ohio pursuant to Sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1934 as amended (the "Act") between Sprint Communications Company L.P. ("Sprint"), a competitive local exchange carrier and Telephone Service Company, an incumbent local exchange carrier ("ILEC"). This request is made pursuant to Section 2 of the current Agreement between the parties dated September 30, 2008. Sprint requests the successor interconnection agreement encompass the carrier duties of Sections 251(a) direct and indirect interconnection, including N11, 251(b)(5) Reciprocal Compensation; 251(b)(2) Number Portability; and, 251(b)(3) Dialing Parity. Sprint's request for interconnection can be accomplished under Sections 251(a) and (b).

Sprint also requests negotiations as provided for in 47 U.S.C. § 252(b)(1) which establishes the statutory timelines as identified in the Act. Should negotiations not be completed between the 135th and 160th day after the receipt of this letter, October 15, 2010 and November 11, 2010, respectively, either party may petition the state commission to arbitrate any unresolved issues.

In compliance with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio's Local Service Guidelines, Section III Interconnection, Sub-section (c) "Bona Fide Request For Interconnection", Sprint provides the following:

1. The technical description of the requested meet point(s) or, in the alternative, the requested point(s) of collocation (e.g., the end office, tandem, etc).

Sprint requests direct or indirect interconnection pursuant to Section 251(a). Sprint suggests interconnection at TOLDOH216GT.

2. For each collocation point: a forecast of DS-1 and DS-3 cross-connects required during the term of the agreement; the requested interface format (electrical vs. optical); the type of collocation (physical or virtual) requested; and, if physical

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collocation is required, the amount of partitioned space required, as well as DC power and environmental conditioning requirements.

3. For each meet point, a detailed technical description of the requested interface equipment must be provided.

Sprint will provision DSIs or DS3s as necessary to exchange traffic with the ILEC.

4. The requested reciprocal compensation arrangement for transport and termination of local traffic.

Sprint suggests that traffic be exchanged on a bill and keep compensation arrangement.

5. A technical description of any required unbundled network elements.

6. Any requested access to poles, ducts, conduits and rights of way owned or controlled by the providing carrier.

7. Any requested white pages directory listings for the customer of the requesting carrier's telephone exchange service.

Sprint requests Directory Listing services.

8. Any requested access to 911, E911, directory assistance, operator call completion service and any required dialing parity capability.

Sprint will require access to the selective router.

9. Any requested telephone numbers for the assignment to the requesting LECS's local exchange service customers.

Sprint will obtain its own telephone numbers in the appropriate rate centers. Additionally, the agreement will establish number porting arrangements.

10. The required method(s) of interim number portability, until long-term number portability is available.

Sprint requests number portability as provided for in 47 U.S.C. §251(b)(2) and under the provisions and timelines established in 47 CFR §§52.23(b) and (c). Sprint requests a list of ILEC's switches for which number portability (1) is available, (2) has been requested but is not yet available or (3) has not yet been requested.

11. An itemized list of the required telecommunications services to be offered for resale by the providing carrier, and required operational support systems associated with the resale of these telecommunications services.

12. If transit traffic functionality is required, the requested method(s) of providing that functionality at each requested point of interconnection pursuant to Section IV of these guidelines.

Tandem transit will be required if the ILEC is the tandem owner and/or provider.

13. The requested completion date.


Sprint requests the agreement be completed 90 days from receipt of this request.

14. A list including names, phone numbers and areas of responsibility of the requesting carrier's contact persons for negotiation purposes.
