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**NOTICE OF AMENDED EXHIBITS**

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Please take notice that on December 23, 2009, Ohio Edison Company (“Ohio Edison”) and U.S. Foodservice (collectively the “Applicants”) filed an application for approval of a special arrangement agreement (“Application”). The Application included Exhibit 2, which listed the project that the Applicants were seeking approval of, the cost of the project, and the amount of energy saved by the implementation of the project. The Application also included Exhibit 3, which described the methodologies used in measuring and verifying the energy efficiency savings realized by the project. Ohio Edison subsequently learned that Exhibit 2 contained a typographical error in the project’s in-service date and that Exhibit 3 omitted a demonstration that the calculation of energy savings conformed to the IPMVP.
