## **Project Overview:**

The Self Direct Prescriptive Lighting project that Northwest Bd of Education has completed and applied is as follows: retrofit of 119 of 4L4'T12 lighting fixtures with 31 4L4'T8 and 88 of 3L4'T8 lighting fixtures, 816 of 3L4'T12 lighting fixtures with 816 of 3L4'T8 lighting fixtures, 66 of 2L4'T12 lighting fixtures with 66 of 2L4'T8 lighting fixtures, 36 2L4'T12 U-shape lighting fixtures with 9 of 2L4'T8 U-shape and 27 of 2L2,T8 lighting fixtures, replacement of 42 fluorescent EXIT signs with 42 of LED EXIT signs and installation of 87 occupancy sensors in classrooms. T12 to T8 conversion, 4-foot delamping, New T8/T5 fixture, LED EXIT signs and Lighting occupancy sensors measures were applied in this project. The documentation that was included with the application proved that the energy measures applied for were purchased and installed.
