The Commission finds:

- (1) On November 5, 2009, Sharon R. Cedeno (complainant) filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio (AT&T) and Windstream Ohio, Inc. (Windstream) alleging that AT&T and Windstream have not accurately billed her for telephone services.
- (2) On December 4, 2009, both AT&T and Windstream filed answers to the complaint, in which they asserted that their services and practices have been in full accordance with all applicable provisions of law and all accepted standards in the telephone industry, and that complainant had failed to state reasonable grounds for complaint.
