ENTRY

The Attorney Examiner finds:

- (1) By entry issued July 13, 2010, the evidentiary hearing in this case was rescheduled to commence on July 28, 2010, and, therefore, the written testimony was due by July 21, 2010.
- (2) In anticipation of a resolution of the issues presented in this matter, the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) requested, and Columbus Southern Power Company, Ohio Power Company, and Staff agreed, the due date for written testimony be extended to July 23, 2010.
- (3) The Attorney Examiner finds OCC's request to extend the due date to file written testimony to be reasonable in light of a potential settlement. Accordingly, the written direct testimony of all parties' witnesses shall be filed with the Commission and served upon all parties on July 23, 2010, by no later than 5:00 p.m. All written testimony shall be promptly served on the other parties and the Attorney Examiner by e-mail.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That OCC's request to extend the due date to file written testimony be granted until July 23, 2010, at 5:00 p.m., as discussed in finding (3). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all persons of record.


