ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On May 24, 2010, quasar-Zanesville Energy (quasar-Zanesville) filed an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility.
- (2) Pursuant to Rule 4901:1-40-04(F)(2), Ohio Administrative Code, this application is subject to a 60-day automatic approval process. The rule also provides that the Commission may suspend an application during the 60-day approval process.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that additional information and investigation is necessary to thoroughly review this application. Therefore, good cause exists to suspend the 60-day automatic approval process for quasar-Zanesville's application for certification, in order for the Commission and its staff to further review this matter.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the automatic approval process for the application of quasar-Zanesville for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility be suspended. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record in this case.


