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## **ENTRY**

## The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Pursuant to Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), the Commission staff has served a notice of preliminary determination upon Ametha Savon (respondent), alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On April 2, 2010, respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in the above-captioned case in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (3) By entry issued June 7, 2010, this matter was set for hearing on July 22, 2010.
- (4) On July 22, 2010, staff filed a motion for a continuance, requesting that the hearing in this matter be continued until further notice. Staff explains that the requested continuance is due to the lack of notice to respondent. Certified service of the June 7, 2010, entry scheduling the hearing was returned unsigned. In addition, respondent indicated to counsel for staff that she has no means to travel to the Commission to attend the hearing at this time.
- (5) The attorney examiner finds that staff's motion for a continuance is reasonable and should be granted. The parties are directed to file a statement every 60 days, updating the attorney examiner of the status of the case. A new hearing date will be scheduled by subsequent entry.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That staff's motion for a continuance of the July 22, 2010, hearing be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the parties file a statement every 60 days, in accordance with finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record by regular U.S. mail.
