ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On December 30, 1997, the attorney examiner called and continued the evidentiary hearing in this case until January 12, 1998.
- (2) By letter submitted January 7, 1998, counsel for Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company (CBT) requested a continuance of the hearing date, until January 26, 1998, in order for CBT to continue settlement discussions with other parties in the case. CBT represents that all other parties either support or do not oppose the proposed continuance.
- (3) CBT's request for a two-week continuance of the hearing is reasonable and shall be granted. The hearing shall be re-scheduled to commence on January 26, 1998, at 9:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission.
