ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On January 8, 1998, the attorney examiner issued an entry granting an unopposed request by Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company (CBT) for a two-week continuance of the hearing in this case. The hearing was rescheduled for January 26, 1998.
- (2) By letter submitted January 22, 1998, counsel for CBT requested an additional continuance of the hearing date, until February 9, 1998, in order for CBT to continue to pursue settlement discussions with other parties in the case. CBT represents that all other parties either support or do not oppose the proposed continuance.
- (3) CBT's request for a two-week continuance of the hearing is reasonable and shall be granted. The hearing shall be rescheduled to commence on February 9, 1998, at 9:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That CBT's unopposed request for a continuance of the evidentiary hearing date, until February 9, 1998, be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.


