ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On May 6, 2010, the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers and Trainmen, Ohio State Legislative Board filed a complaint alleging that an unsafe condition exists on the property of the Wheeling & Lake Erie Railway (W&LE) due to the presence of debris, rocks, wood, and metal lying in a walkway.
- (2) Staff has filed findings that W&LE has eliminated the unsafe and hazardous conditions on its property that were the subject of the complaint. Accordingly, this complaint should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the complaint is dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the Commission serve a copy of this entry upon all parties of record.


