Description of the Parties

I. NTELOS

NTELOS Inc. is a Virginia Corporation and a wholly-owned subsidiary of NTELOS Holdings Corp. (NASDAQ: NTLS). Through its subsidiaries, NTELOS provides telecommunications services to customers, including Wireless, Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier ("ILEC"), Competitive Local Exchange Carriers ("CLEC"), Data and Carrier's Carrier services.

NTELOS is a leading provider of wireless and wireline communications services to consumers and businesses primarily in Virginia, West Virginia and Pennsylvania under the NTELOS brand name. Founded in 1897 as the Clifton Forge-Waynesboro Telephone Company, NTELOS' wireline business and its predecessor organizations have a long history of providing exceptional telephone service in the rural Virginia cities of Waynesboro and Covington, and portions of Alleghany, Augusta and Botetourt counties as incumbent Local Exchange Carriers ("ILECs"). As of December 31, 2009, NTELOS operated approximately 38,200 rural ILEC lines.

With the launch of Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC) services in 1998, NTELOS' wireline business has evolved from a traditional, rural ILEC into a regional provider of transport, IP, video, voice and data services. NTELOS is certificated as a CLEC in Virginia, West Virginia, Pennsylvania and Maryland. As of December 31, 2009, NTELOS had approximately 49,700 CLEC lines, virtually all business, across 31 markets. The heart of NTELOS' wireline business is an extensive 4,700 route-mile fiber optic network used to backhaul communications traffic for retail services; to serve as a carriers' carrier network; and to provide transport services to third parties for long distance, internet, wireless and private network services. NTELOS offers its customers leading edge technology services, including Metro Ethernet and IP-based services.

NTELOS also holds Personal Communication Service (PCS) licenses to operate in twenty-nine basic trading areas with a total licensed population of approximately 8.8 million. NTELOS has built out its network in twenty of those basic trading areas and covers over 5.5 million Points of Presence (POPs). NTELOS now serves over 440,000 retail wireless

subscribers representing approximately 8% penetration of NTELOS' total covered population. In 2006, NTELOS acquired seven Advanced Wireless Services (AWS) licenses in western Virginia. These AWS licenses are 20 MHz each and are located in the Roanoke, Lynchburg, Giles, Bedford, Charlottesville, Bath, and Highland CMAs.

NTELOS began acquiring PCS spectrum in western Virginia and West Virginia in the mid-90s and introduced service in western Virginia in late 1997, in West Virginia in late 1998, and in eastern Virginia (Richmond, Hampton Roads, Norfolk, Virginia Beach) in 2000.

NTELOS continues to make significant investments in its wireless network. During 2008, NTELOS added 160 new wireless sites to end the year with a total of 1,183 cell sites. It added 64 more sites in 2009 and 24 more so far this year, with 45 more planned by the end of 2010.

NTELOS has 75 company-owned retail stores and supplements its company-owned distribution channels with agents operating a total of 316 retail locations where NTELOS wireless products and services are sold.

In August of 2007, NTELOS announced that it would upgrade virtually its entire network for mobile broadband services using Evolution-Data Optimized (EVDO) Rev. A. EVDO data services are at speeds 10 times faster than those available on NTELOS' 1x data network – the wireless equivalent of moving from dial-up to DSL. NTELOS completely replaced the wireless switches in its western Virginia and West Virginia networks; upgraded the existing switches in eastern Virginia; and changed out equipment at over 1,000 cell sites. In 2008, NTELOS completed the EVDO deployment in western Virginia and West Virginia. On July 9, 2009, NTELOS announced the completion of the EVDO broadband upgrade in its Virginia East market, including Richmond, Hampton Roads, Norfolk, and Virginia Beach.

II. FiberNet of Ohio, LLC

FiberNet of Ohio, LLC ("FiberNet"), which is headquartered in Charleston, West Virginia, is authorized by the PUCO to provide services in Ohio through PUCO Certificate No. 90-9201. FiberNet is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Mountaineer Telecommunications, LLC ("Mountaineer"), a West Virginia LLC, non-certificated holding company, and wholly owned subsidiary of Conversent Communications, Inc. ("Conversent"), a Delaware corporation, non-

certificated holding company and wholly-owned subsidiary of One Communications Corp. ("One"), also a Delaware corporation and non-certificated holding company.

Formed in 1997 as a small, customer-focused and solutions-based company, FiberNet and its affiliated FiberNet operating subsidiaries (the "Company") have evolved into a strong regional company. Facing a broad competitive landscape, the Company pursued a strategy focused on building and owning fiber rather than leasing it from incumbent carriers. Through a series of fiber installations and the acquisition of fiber assets, the Company has developed an extensive fiber network that today spans over 3,500 route miles. The network covers all of West Virginia and extends into surrounding areas in Ohio, Maryland, Pennsylvania, Virginia and Kentucky. The Company is a leader in its regional markets, offering retail voice and data services with over 90% of its lines serving business customers. In addition, the Company offers transport and IP-based services for regional business and wholesale customers.

Operations for FiberNet are hubbed in Charleston, West Virginia. The company operates a 24x7 NOC with two Class 5 voice switches (Alcatel-Lucent 5ESS and a Metaswitch Softswitch). FiberNet offers seamless transmission of data and voice over a 100% fiber optic, self-healing Synchronous Optical Network (SONET) and Dense Wave Division Multiplexing (DWDM) network extending from the customers' premises to carrier interconnection points. By delivering carrier-class backbone reliability directly to its customers' premises, the Company is able to deliver superior levels of connectivity and service with limited reliance on an incumbent carrier. Utilizing the fiber optic infrastructure, FiberNet operates multiple SONET ring networks based primarily on Cisco's Optical Network Solutions multi-service equipment for transport. These networks range in speed from OC-3 through OC-192 and are engineered for high availability. FiberNet has also recently deployed Dense Wave Division Multiplexing across several transport spans throughout the network allowing up to forty 10Gbps wavelengths to be transported over a single pair of fiber. The network is connected to major carrier networks and includes approximately 100 collocations.

Description of the Transaction, Including Public Interest Concerns

I. The Transaction

On July 19, 2010, NTELOS Inc. entered into a purchase agreement to acquire 100% of the outstanding equity interests of Mountaineer, including its subsidiary, FiberNet of Ohio, LLC, from Conversent. Pursuant to the purchase agreement, NTELOS will pay cash consideration of approximately \$170 million for the Mountaineer equity interests. NTELOS intends to fund the purchase through a combination of a permitted incremental term loan under its existing senior credit facility, availability under the undrawn revolver, and cash on hand. Mountaineer is the parent company of FiberNet; FiberNet, L.L.C.; FiberNet of Virginia, Inc.; FiberNet Telecommunications of Pennsylvania, LLC and FiberNet of Ohio, LLC. NTELOS intends to create a new wholly-owned subsidiary to purchase and hold Mountaineer and, thus, FiberNet. It will be a Virginia corporation and will be called NTELOS FiberNet Inc. NTELOS FiberNet Inc. will be 100% owned by NTELOS.

NTELOS' acquisition of FiberNet is subject to receiving approval from the FCC and the relevant state regulatory commissions (in addition to Ohio; West Virginia, Virginia, Pennsylvania and Maryland) as well as anti-trust review under the Hart-Scott-Rodino Act. Pending all approvals, the acquisition is expected to close in the fourth quarter of 2010. The purchase agreement is subject to termination if the acquisition is not completed before December 31, 2010.

As a result of the transaction, FiberNet will be ultimately owned by NTELOS rather than One. Diagrams showing the corporate structure of FiberNet before the transaction and the structure of NTELOS after the transaction are attached hereto.

II. The Public Interest

A. Transaction is in the Public Interest

The proposed transaction will create a combined company with double the scope and size of the existing companies. Brought together, NTELOS and FiberNet combined will be able to compete more effectively in the highly competitive market for telecommunications services. The

combined company will benefit from increased economies of scale that will permit it to operate more efficiently and provide high quality service to an increased number of customers. The creation of a larger, financially stronger telecommunications competitor would benefit consumers. After the acquisition, NTELOS and FiberNet will both continue to provide high-quality communications services to their customers without interruption and without change in rates, terms or conditions.

B. Transaction Will be Seamless to Customers


The transaction will be transparent to customers, as they will not experience any change in service, rates, terms or conditions. FiberNet will continue to operate under its PUCO approved tariffs and the name of the operating company will be unchanged at this time. Any future changes to rates, terms, conditions, or other regulated pursuits will be made in accordance with PUCO requirements.

Because this transaction will be completely transparent to the customers of FiberNet, no notice to customers is required pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code Section 4901:1-6-14(B)(3).


C. Transaction Poses no Competitive Risk


Pre-and Post-Transaction Corporate Organization




NTELOS Wireless Coverage




NTELOS Existing Wireline




Existing FiberNet
