ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Commission Staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Carlos Goad (respondent), in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) Respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (3) On April 14, 2010, Staff filed a notification requesting that the Commission dismiss the case. Staff stated in its notification that the respondent has paid the forfeiture in the case.
- (4) Rule 4901:2-7-22, O.A.C., provides, in pertinent part, that payment of a forfeiture demanded in a violation notice shall terminate all further proceedings regarding that violation.
- (5) In view of the respondent's payment of the forfeiture, this case should be closed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the above-captioned case be closed. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.


