ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On September 14, 2009, Forest Hills Supermarket, Inc., dba Konnis Family Foods (complainant) filed a complaint against The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI), alleging that, after a power loss in the surrounding area not affecting the complainant, CEI improperly shut off complainant's power, without notice, resulting in a loss of refrigerated items.
- (2) On October 5, 2009, CEI filed its answer to the complaint, as well as a motion to dismiss the complaint, denying the allegations in the complaint and stating that CEI has not violated any rule, regulation, or tariff provision.
- (3) On July 21, 2010, the parties filed a joint request to dismiss this case with prejudice, stating that the parties have reached a settlement which resolves all of the disputed issues in this case.
- (4) In light of the resolution of the complaint, the Commission finds that the parties' request to dismiss the complaint with prejudice is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the parties' request to dismiss the complaint with prejudice be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Case No. 09-800-EL-CSS be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
