## **NOTICE OF DISMISSAL**

The Staff of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (Staff) hereby agrees to withdraw its notice of preliminary determination served upon Douglas Tipton (Respondent) under Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code. After a review of the facts in the case and discussions with the Respondent, the Staff has concluded that further prosecution of this matter is not warranted. The Staff determined that there is a lack of evidence upon which to proceed to an administrative hearing, and the Ohio State Highway Patrol requested that the case be dismissed.

The Staff has discussed the matter with the Respondent. The Respondent agrees that there is no need to continue the administrative hearing process. Accordingly, the parties request that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio dismiss the case and order that the violations be removed from the Respondent's history of violations.
