The Commission finds:

- (1) On May 4, 2010, Mason Dixon Intermodal, Inc. (respondent), requested an administrative hearing, thereby initiating this case.
- (2) On August 11, 2010, Commission staff filed a letter noting that respondent has paid the forfeiture in the case.
- (3) Rule 4901:2-7-22, Ohio Administrative Code provides, in pertinent part, that payment of the forfeiture shall terminate all further proceedings regarding that violation.
