<u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 4, 1999, Jeff Stevens, Stevens Car Care, Inc. filed a complaint against Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI) alleging that CEI employees demanded payment of a previously paid bill. CEI filed an answer admitting, in part, and denying, in part, that allegations in the complaint.
- (2) A settlement conference was held on April 6, 1999; however the parties were unable to resolve this matter. On several occasions following the conference, both parties requested that they be given additional time to resolve the complaint.
- (3) On December 21, 1999, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss and indicated that they had resolved all of the issues in the complaint and requested the Commission dismiss this matter with prejudice. As the parties have resolved this matter, the complaint should be dismissed with prejudice and the case should be closed of record.

ORDERED, That the complaint be dismissed with prejudice and this case closed of record. It is, further,
