The Commission finds:


- (1) This civil forfeiture case was filed on March 24, 2010. Thereafter, a prehearing conference was held and a hearing was scheduled in the matter for August 17, 2010.
- (2) On August 11, 2010, the Commission's staff (Staff) filed a notice of dismissal. In the notice of dismissal, staff states that after a review of the facts in this case and discussions with the respondent, Staff has concluded that further prosecution of this matter is not warranted. Staff has determined that there is a lack of evidence upon which to proceed to an administrative hearing. The Ohio State Highway Patrol requested that the Commission dismiss this case.
- (3) In view of staff's notice of dismissal, this case should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Case No. 10-392-TR-CVF be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.






