MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME IN WHICH TO ACTIVATE  
TELEPHONE NUMBERING RESOURCES

---

MCImetro Access Transmission Services d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services (“Verizon”) respectfully requests that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (“PUCO” or “Commission”) grant Verizon an extension of time in which to activate one thousands-block of telephone numbers assigned to it in the Cambridge rate center. The number block, 740-421-3XXX, was assigned on February 3, 2010 and has exceeded the due date to submit the confirmation of “in service” to Neustar. Reclamation of the numbers would cause Verizon and a major customer significant hardship. Verizon requests an extension of ninety (90) days in which to place the affected telephone numbering resources into service.

Verizon has encountered some delays turning up service for its customer who will use the assigned number block. However, the customer has signed a contract and the installation order associated with the contract is expected to be completed in early-October. To ensure service will be available for this customer, and Verizon’s current available numbering resources do not become subject to reclamation, Verizon requests it

be granted a 90-day extension in which to place the affected telephone numbering resources into service.

If this block is reclaimed, it would adversely impact the business needs of this customer. An extension of time in which to activate the numbering resources is appropriate, given the short duration of the requested extension and the expectation that the numbering resources have an immediate and identifiable use.

For the foregoing reasons, Verizon respectfully requests that its Motion be granted.
