Pursuant to the Attorney Examiner's Entry of September 3, 2010, the East Ohio Gas Company d/b/a Dominion East Ohio ("DEO") hereby provides this statement informing the Commission whether the issues raised in the Comments filed on September 24, 2010 have been resolved.

The major issue in this case has been resolved. DEO has agreed to the PIR Cost Recovery Charge of \$1.58 proposed by Commission Staff and Office of Ohio Consumers' Counsel ("OCC"). The parties are in the process of memorializing their agreement in a Stipulation and Recommendation that will be submitted to the Commission, along with supporting testimony.

OCC raises additional issues in its Comments that do not relate to the calculation of the PIR Cost Recovery Charge, but has advised DEO that it does not intend to submit testimony concerning these issues. Accordingly, DEO anticipates that the evidentiary hearing will be limited to the introduction into evidence of the Stipulation and Recommendation and associated exhibits.
