## MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

On September 1, 2010, Columbus Southern Power Company and Ohio Power Company ("Companies") filed a letter and supporting testimony to initiate the administration of the significantly excessive earnings test ("SEET") for 2009. Subsequently, on September 21, 2010, the attorney examiner issued an entry establishing a procedural schedule for this proceeding. Pursuant to this entry, Staff's and intervenors' testimony is due on October 12, 2010. Staff, however, has determined that additional time is needed to prepare its testimony and therefore requests an extension of the deadline.

The individuals assigned to this case on behalf of Staff are involved in a number of other SEET proceedings that are currently before the Commission on a similar timeframe as the Companies' case. Due to the significant time and effort involved in analyzing all of the various factors and related data that are associated with the SEET, Staff requests that the deadline of October 12, 2010 for the filing of Staff's testimony be extended to October 21, 2010. Rule 4901-1-13(A) of the Ohio Administrative Code provides for extensions where good cause is shown. Staff believes that good cause exists in these circumstances. This is a significant case involving the first administration of the SEET, and additional time is needed so that Staff may evaluate all of the relevant data and make an appropriate and well-informed recommendation to the Commission.

In light of the short timeframe remaining before Staff's testimony is due, Staff further requests an expedited ruling on this motion pursuant to Rule 4901-1-12(C) of the

Ohio Administrative Code. Staff has contacted all of the parties to this proceeding to determine whether they object to the issuance of an expedited ruling without the filing of memoranda. The Companies object to Staff's request. All of the other parties to this proceeding (Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel, Industrial Energy Users-Ohio, Ohio Partners for Affordable Energy, Ohio Energy Group, Appalachian Peace and Justice Network, Ohio Manufacturers' Association, and Ohio Hospital Association) have no objection.

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Therefore, Staff respectfully requests that its motion for an extension and request for an expedited ruling be granted.
