ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On September 9, 2010, Lake Village Club, Inc. (Lake Village) filed a complaint against Camplands Water LLC (Camplands) in which it alleges that Camplands' rates are unjust and discriminatory. Lake Village also alleges that Camplands provides inadequate service.
- (2) On September 28, 2010, pursuant to Rule 4901-1-13(A), Ohio Administrative Code, Camplands moved to extend the time to file an answer. In support of its motion, Camplands explains that Docketing mailed the complaint to Camplands' Andover, Ohio address, the location of the physical plant of the water facility. The complaint was not forwarded to Marvin Goldenberg, president of the company in a timely manner. Camplands further explains that Mr. Goldenberg was away from his residence in Boston, Massachusetts until September 27, 2010. It was not until then that he saw the complaint. He notified counsel by voicemail after business hours on the same day. Counsel returned the call on September 28, 2010. Counsel determined that it would not be feasible to prepare an answer or other pleading before the September 30, 2010, time period for filing an answer. Therefore, Camplands requests a period of 30 days from the date of its motion to file an answer to the complaint.

- (3) By means of a conference call, the attorney examiner determined that opposing counsel does not object to Camplands' motion to extend time. Finding good cause and upon being advised that there is no objection, the motion to extend time shall be granted. Accordingly, the respondent shall be granted until October 28, 2010, to file an answer.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That Camplands' motion to extend the time to file an answer to the complaint is granted. It is, further,
