## The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On September 20, 2010, Industrial Energy Users-Ohio (IEU-Ohio) filed a complaint against The Midwest Independent Transmission System Operator, Inc., (MISO) and Duke Energy Ohio, Inc., (Duke).
- (2) On September 29, 2010, Duke filed a motion for extension of time and request for expedited ruling, requesting that the time for Duke to file an answer to the complaint be extended until ten days after the Commission rules on a motion to dismiss, which Duke represented would be filed by October 12, 2010. By entry dated October 7, 2010, the attorney examiner granted the motion for an extension.
- (3) On October 8, 2010, MISO filed a motion for an extension of time, requesting that the time for MISO to file its answer also be extended until ten days after the Commission rules on a motion to dismiss which MISO intends to file by October 15, 2010. Further, MISO represented that IEU-Ohio did not object to the extension.

(4) The attorney examiner finds that MISO's motion is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, MISO should file its answer in this proceeding ten days after the Commission rules on MISO's motion to dismiss, provided that the motion to dismiss is filed no later than October 15, 2010.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That MISO's motion for extension and request for expedited ruling be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
