**Project Overview:**

The Self Direct Prescriptive project that CVS Pharmacy has completed and applied for is the installation of (135) new fluorescent fixtures in 9,800 ft<sup>2</sup> of retail space. This project involves new construction lighting power density measure 2LampF32T8 and metal halide fixtures are installed at this facility. The total reduction in lighting power density for this facility, by comparing to the ASHRAE standard for Retail stores, is 6.6kW. The documentation that was included with the application proved that the energy measures applied for were purchased and installed.
