The Self Direct Prescriptive project that CVS Corporation has completed and applied for is the installation of (237) new fluorescent fixtures in 10,747 ft² of retail space. This project involves new construction lighting power density measure. The total reduction in lighting power density for this facility, by comparing to the ASHRAE standard for Retail stores, is 1.07kW. The documentation that was included with the application proved that the energy measures applied for were purchased and installed.
