The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) Rule 4901:1-13-11, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), lists the specific information to be provided by natural gas companies on residential gas bills. Rule 4901:1-13-11(D), O.A.C., requires that a company proposing any new bill format shall file its proposed bill format with the Commission for approval. In addition, Paragraph (D) states that an application for a new bill format becomes effective after 45 days, unless the Commission specifically rules otherwise.
- (2) On September 8, 2010, Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia) filed the instant application requesting approval of new bill formats.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that additional time is needed to review the application and, therefore, the automatic approval of this application should be suspended, until the Commission orders otherwise.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the automatic approval of this application be suspended, until the Commission orders otherwise. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.


