Gentlemen:

The Ohio State Legislative Board, United Transportation Union, representing Ohio railroad employees wishes to file a weed and vegetation complaint (Ohio Administrative Codes 4901-5-05 and 4901-5-07) against CSX Transportation (CSXT), which railroad is subject to regulation under Chapters 4905 and 4907 of the Revised Code.

In conducting its railroad operation in the vicinity of Carey, Wyandot County, Ohio, said company has permitted unsafe and hazardous walking/tripping conditions to arise due to the excessive growth of weeds and vegetation on its property at the following location:

At Milepost CD 71 to CD 73 along tracks 1, 2, and the Center Siding, the vegetation in this area is approximately waist high and is affecting approximately 70 percent of the area indicated.

The area can be reached from Columbus, Ohio, by traveling north to US-23 and then turning north (right) on Elm Hill Road (Township Hwy. 98). In around a mile you will cross the location and tracks indicated above.

By its failure to establish or maintain an adequate vegetation control program early in the season, it is now endangering the railroad employees required to use this area in the performance of their required duties.

It is requested that an investigation be conducted, under Section 4907.08, to determine if this railroad at the above location is in violation of your Commission's "Weed Order." Ιf The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ATTENTION: Ms. Leah Thomas-Dalton October 19, 2010

excessive growth is found, then an appropriate and timely order should be issued to require the elimination of the growth and the establishment of a vegetation control program to prevent the recurrence of such unsafe conditions.
