<u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) On August 12, 2009, the commercial motor vehicle driven by the respondent, Mr. Noah, was stopped and inspected. As a result of that inspection, Mr. Noah was cited under 49 C.F.R. 391.11(b)(4), for not wearing hearing aids at the time of the stop.
- (2) This civil forfeiture case was filed on March 26, 2010.
- (3) Thereafter, a prehearing conference was held and a hearing was scheduled in the matter.
- (4) On October 13, 2010, Commission staff filed a letter requesting that this case be dismissed. In its letter, staff stated that further prosecution of this matter is not warranted and that there is a lack of evidence upon which to proceed to an administrative hearing.
- (5) In view of staff's request for dismissal, this case should be dismissed. Further, the violation should be deleted from the inspection report.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Case No. 10-408-TR-CVF be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the violation be deleted from the inspection report. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.
