To whom it may concern:

This office has recently received a safety complaint against the Wheeling and Lake Erie Railroad., a common rail carrier within the State of Ohio.

More specifically, on their Cleveland Subdivision line, it has been reported that vegetation has overgrown the railroad and/or vehicular right of way. This occurs at the following milepost locations: MPQ 40.6 – 40.8; MPQ 47.1 - MPQ 47.3; MPQ 58.0 and MPQ 59.1.

Rail employees have repeatedly reported this condition to be unsafe. Unfortunately, the W&LE has refused to remedy the problem.

I ask that PUCO investigate this issue and if deemed to pose an unsafe working condition require W&LE to remove the overgrown weeds.
