2	October 4, 2010.	
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4	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Let's go on the	
5	record. The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio has	
6	called for hearing at this time and place Case No.	
7	09-1862-GA-AIR, that being in the Matter of the	
8	Application of Piedmont Gas Company, Inc. for an	
9	Increase in Rates and Changes for Natural Gas	
10	Service.	
11	My name is Jeffrey R. Jones, I'm the	
12	Attorney Examiner who's been assigned to this hearing	
13	today.	
14	Let's take appearances on behalf of the	
15	parties. On behalf of the applicant Piedmont Gas	
16	Company.	
17	MR. HOWARD: Thank you, your Honor.	
18	Would you please have the record reflect the	
19	appearance of the law firm of Vorys, Sater, Seymour	
20	and Pease, 52 East Gay Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215	
21	by Stephen M. Howard on behalf of the applicant	
22	Piedmont Gas Company, thank you.	
23	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you,	
24	Mr. Howard.	
25	On behalf of the staff?	

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1	MR. WRIGHT: Thank you, your Honor, good
2	morning. On behalf of the Ohio Attorney General
3	Richard Cordray and the Public Utilities Commission
4	Sections, my name is Bill Wright, 180 East Broad
5	Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
6	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you, Mr.
7	Wright.
8	At this time do we have any preliminary
9	matters it take up?
10	MR. HOWARD: Yes, your Honor. Piedmont
11	Gas Company wishes to express its appreciation and
12	gratefulness to the staff for their work on this case
13	and we have reached a stipulation in this case.
14	If it would be appropriate I'd like to
15	ask the Bench to mark a few exhibits and introduce
16	them at this time.
17	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Let's go ahead and
18	mark those, Mr. Howard.
19	MR. HOWARD: Thank you, your Honor. We
20	would ask that Piedmont Exhibit No. 1, which is the
21	Small Utility Application for an Increase in Rates
22	and Charges, consisting of about 118 pages, be marked
23	as Piedmont Exhibit No. 1.
24	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Shall be so marked.
25	(EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.)

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1	MR. HOWARD: We would ask that a			
2	document multi-page document being the Proof of			
3	Publication of the application which was published			
4	once a week for three consecutive weeks in The Times			
5	Reporter be marked as Piedmont Exhibit No. 2.			
6	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Is shall be so			
7	marked.			
8	(EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.)			
9	MR. HOWARD: We would also ask that a			
10	multi-page document entitled Stipulation and			
11	Recommendation which would include addendums A, B, C,			
12	and D, be marked as Joint Exhibit No. 1. That was			
13	filed on Friday, October 1 in this matter.			
14	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: That document shall			
15	be so marked.			
16	(EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.)			
17	MR. HOWARD: In addition, Piedmont			
18	respectfully requests leave to file as a late-filed			
19	exhibit Piedmont Exhibit No. 3 which would be the			
20	Proof of Publication indicating that notice of the			
21	hearing which was held on September 29 be marked as			
22	Piedmont Exhibit 3, and we would ask leave to file			
23	that as a late-filed exhibit.			
24	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you, that			
25	document will be marked Piedmont Exhibit 3.			

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1	(EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.)	
2	MR. HOWARD: Two other items on Joint	
3	Exhibit No. 1 that we just marked and identified,	
4	there is a typographical error in that and I wanted	
5	to call that to the Bench's attention.	
6	On page 4, item 1, the second line,	
7	there's a reference to a statutory section and it	
8	reads Section 4905.03(A)(6). In the Revised Code	
9	that refers to (6) should be (5).	
10	And Mr. Wright I believe concurs with	
11	that and we would ask that that be noted for the	
12	record.	
13	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you, it will	
14	be, Mr. Howard.	
15	MR. HOWARD: And finally, in the Staff	
16	Report of investigation there is a recommendation of	
17	the staff that the applicant file an updated rate	
18	case expense.	
19	While not asking that to be marked as an	
20	exhibit I would like the record to reflect that a	
21	copy has been provided to Mr. Wright and to the Bench	
22	indicating an updated rate case expense.	
23	The Staff Report has an amount of	
24	\$15,000 as rate case expense. We would expect to	
25	exceed that but we but Piedmont is willing to

1	accept the rate case expense allowance of \$15,000 for
2	purposes of this case.
3	Thank you.
4	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Thank you,
5	Mr. Howard.
6	Let's go ahead and mark any other
7	documents. Mr. Wright, do you have any at this time?
8	MR. WRIGHT: Yes, your Honor, I have one.
9	And I would like to have it marked as Staff Exhibit
10	No. 1, the Staff Report that was prepared and filed
11	by the staff in this case back on August 12, 2010.
12	Copies have been provided to the Bench and to the
13	reporter.
14	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: That shall be marked
15	Staff Exhibit No. 1 thank you.
16	(EXHIBIT MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.)
17	MR. WRIGHT: Thank you.
18	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Are there any other
19	exhibits that needs to be marked at this time?
20	MR. WRIGHT: No, your Honor the answer
21	is no. We do have a witness Mr. Goins we would like
22	to put on. Should just take a minute or two to
23	explain one difference between what appears in Joint
24	Exhibit 1 and the stipulation and what appears in the
25	Staff Report.

9 1 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: I will take admission 2 of documents after Mr. Goins' testimony. 3 MR. WRIGHT: I would move, by the way, 4 for admission of Staff Exhibit 1 subject to Mr. Goins 5 taking the stand. 6 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Mr. Goins, you want 7 to take the stand now? 8 (Witness sworn.) 9 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Please be seated. 10 You may proceed, Mr. Wright. 11 MR. WRIGHT: Thank you, your Honor. 12 13 CHUCK GOINS 14 being first duly sworn, as prescribed by law, was 15 examined and testified as follows: 16 DIRECT EXAMINATION 17 By Mr. Wright: 18 Q. Good morning, Mr. Goins. 19 A. Good morning. 20 Q. Please state your name for the record. 21 Yes, my name is Chuck Goins. Α. 22 Q. And you're employed by the Public 23 Utilities Commission of Ohio? 24 Α. Yes, I am. 25 Q. And what is your position?

1	A. I'm a utility specialist in the Rates and
2	Tariffs Division of the Commission's Utilities
3	Department.
4	Q. And as part of your job functions in that
5	position I assume you're responsible for development
6	of rates in a case such as this?
7	A. That's correct.
8	Q. Now, do you have in your possession the
9	stipulation, Mr. Goins?
10	A. Yes, I do.
11	Q. Could you please turn to Addendum B at
12	the back?
13	A. I have it.
14	Q. Could you please identify Addendum B?
15	Just generally.
16	A. Addendum B are the typical bills that
17	were generated from the revenues that was located in
18	this case.
19	Q. And you understand you're being sponsored
20	today to explain the differences between Addendum B
21	in the stipulation and what would have appeared as
22	pages 66, 67, and 68 in the Staff Report; is that
23	right?
24	A. Yes.
25	Q. Now, to the extent there are differences

1 could you briefly explain why, differences between the stipulation and the Staff Report? 2 3 The reason there were differences in the Α. 4 Staff Report in comparison to the stipulation is that 5 during the investigatory process, us in the Rates and 6 Tariffs Division, what we will do is as the 7 Accounting and Electricity Division makes adjustments 8 to the revenue that they're recommending, what we 9 will do is we will take that revenue and we will 10 develop rates on that to get a typical bill 11 comparison to see what the rate impact is going to be 12 on the average customer's bill. 13 During that process, and that changes, 14 just depends on how many adjustments are made by 15 Accounting and Electricity that changes numerous 16 times throughout the investigatory proceeding. 17 And this for instance what happened was 18 the last adjustments that were made by the Accounting 19 and Electricity Division, they were not included in 20 the rates that were generated and put into the Staff 21 Report. 22 So even though the revenue was correct, 23 the rates that were included that reflected that 24 revenue were erroneous. So basically there was an

1	A. Yes, there was an error.
2	Q. To include the most recent.
3	A. That's correct.
4	Q. Now, the Addendum B to the stipulation is
5	not a wholesale change of the Staff Report, correct?
6	A. Correct.
7	Q. And I believe you just indicated all that
8	really changed were the rates.
9	A. That's correct.
10	Q. Could you please go to the third page of
11	the three-page addendum?
12	A. I have it.
13	Q. And more specifically could you explain
14	what did change? The changes appear to this page; is
15	that correct?
16	A. Yes.
17	Q. Could you please explain for the record
18	what did change?
19	A. What's changed is staff's proposed rates.
20	That's what changed when you look at this page.
21	The currently rates then, the proposed
22	rates which were proposed by the company, staff's
23	proposed rates are what changed. Once we get the
24	revenue from the Accounting/Electricity Division we
25	generate rates based upon that revenue.

1	We did that you but the rates that were
2	included were the wrong rates. They were from a
3	prior adjustment, not from the very last adjustment.
4	So it's that last column the staff proposed rates,
5	those are the numbers that are going to change or
6	that have changed
7	Q. When you say "last column," you're
8	referring to the column on the farther right?
9	A. Yes, that say "Staff's Proposed Rates."
10	Q. Very good.
11	MR. WRIGHT: Your Honor, that's all the
12	questions we have. Thank you.
13	
14	EXAMINATION
15	By Attorney Examiner:
16	Q. Mr. Goins, I think just one other
17	clarification type question for my own purposes.
18	A. Okay.
19	Q. Referring to the same page that
20	Mr. Wright just referred you to, were there also
21	changes in columns above where you just referenced
22	"Staff Proposed Rates," that would be under
23	"Transportation Staff Proposed" column, "Dollar
24	Increase" column, and "Percent Increase" column, were
25	those also changed in the Staff Report if you know?

1	A. Yes. And that's because these typical
2	bills are reflecting the proper rates. So yes, I
3	should have I'm sorry, I should have said that
4	changed also. Because if we're going to be
5	developing rates based on that revenue, that's always
6	going to change. It's going to be reflective. So I
7	should have said that also.
8	Q. Okay. But it is just the "Staff Proposed
9	Rates" and the "Dollar Increase" associated with the
10	staff proposal that changed on those documents,
11	right?
12	A. That's correct.
13	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: I don't have anything
14	further.
15	Did you have any questions Mr. Howard?
16	MR. HOWARD: No questions. Thank you,
17	your Honor.
18	Thanks, Mr. Goins.
19	THE WITNESS: You're very welcome.
20	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: You may step down.
21	Are there any further witnesses we need
22	to hear from today?
23	MR. WRIGHT: No, your Honor.
24	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: If not, I believe we
25	have marked and moved Piedmont Exhibit 1 which is the

1	application, Piedmont Exhibit 2, the proof of
2	publication of the application, a late-filed exhibit
3	Piedmont Exhibit 3 which is proof of publication in a
4	local public hearing, Joint Exhibit 1, which is the
5	stipulation and recommendation docketed on October 1,
6	2010, and the Staff Exhibit 1, which is the Staff
7	Report docketed on August 12, 2010.
8	Is that all the exhibits, am I correct?
9	MR. WRIGHT: You are correct.
10	MR. HOWARD: That's correct, your Honor,
11	thank you.
12	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Any objection to the
13	admission mix of those documents that I just
14	outlined?
15	MR. HOWARD: No objection.
16	MR. WRIGHT: No, your Honor.
17	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: If not, all those
18	documents shall be admitted.
19	(EXHIBITS ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.)
20	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Anything further that
21	needs to come before us today?
22	MR. WRIGHT: No, your Honor.
23	MR. HOWARD: No, your Honor.
24	ATTORNEY EXAMINER: At this time the
25	hearing will be recessed and the Commission will take

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1	it ı	up based	on this record. Thank you.	
2			MR. WRIGHT: Thank you very much.	
3			MR. HOWARD: Thank you.	
4			(Hearing adjourned at 10:27 a.m.)
