The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) On April 1, 2010, the above-captioned respondent filed a request for administrative hearing pursuant to Rule 4901:2-7-13, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), to contest the alleged violations of the Commission's transportation regulations and/or civil forfeitures assessed in the notice of preliminary determination for the above-captioned inspection report.
- (2) Pursuant to Rule 4901:2-7-16(B), O.A.C., a prehearing conference was conducted on October 28, 2010. As no settlement was reached at that time, this matter will be scheduled for hearing on Wednesday, January 19, 2011, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern time, at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
- (3) Failure to attend the hearing may result in a finding, under Rule 4901:2-7-14(A), O.A.C., that the respondent is deemed to have admitted the occurrence of the violations, and has waived all further right to contest liability to the state for the forfeiture described in the notice. In addition, Rule 4901-1-08, O.A.C. requires that corporations, such as the respondent in this case, be represented by an attorney-at-law. Accordingly, if the respondent wishes to cross-examine witnesses or offer any arguments on its behalf, the respondent must be represented by counsel at the hearing.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this matter be scheduled for hearing on January 19, 2011, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern time, at the offices of the Commission in Hearing Room 11-C. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.


