The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On October 21, 2010, the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC), Border Energy, Inc. (Border), Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (NOPEC), Stand Energy Corporation (Stand), and the Ohio Farm Bureau Federation (OFBF) filed a complaint against Interstate Gas Supply, Inc. (IGS), alleging IGS d/b/a Columbia Retail Energy has engaged in marketing, solicitation, sales acts, or practices that are unfair, misleading, deceptive, or unconscionable.
- (2) On November 8, 2010, IGS filed a motion requesting an extension of time in which to file its answer until November 12, 2010. In support of its request, IGS states that its need for an extension is due to an unforeseen personal matter. Moreover, IGS certified that it has contacted the parties to this proceeding and no party objects to the extension. The attorney examiner finds that IGS' motion is reasonable and should be granted.
