The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) Commission staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Nolker Trucking LLC (respondent), in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), alleging a violation of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On November 17, 2010, respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C.
- (3) As set forth in Rule 4901:2-7-16(B), O.A.C., unless otherwise ordered by the Commission or agreed by the parties, a prehearing conference in a civil forfeiture case shall be scheduled within 30 day of the filing of a request for administrative hearing.
- (4) The parties in this case are directed to participate in a prehearing conference on December 20, 2010, at 10 a.m., Eastern Daylight time. At that time, the attorney examiner will attempt to contact respondent by telephone.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a prehearing conference in this case be scheduled in accordance with Finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.


