The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On December 17, 2010, the attorney examiner issued an entry scheduling a hearing in this matter on January 6, 2011.
- (2) On December 30, 2010, staff filed a motion for continuance of the hearing. Staff explained that its witnesses for the hearing, both Ohio State Highway Patrol inspectors, are scheduled for training on January 6, 2011, and cannot attend the hearing. Staff adds that its ability to present a case would be severely hindered by the absence of the inspectors. Staff also states that the rights of Angelo Cross, the Respondent, would not be prejudiced by a continuance of the hearing date. Staff concludes by requesting an expedited ruling, given the pending immediacy of the January 6, 2011, date, and given its continued attempts to contact the Respondent.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that staff's motion for a continuance of the hearing is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the January 6, 2011, hearing is continued. The next hearing date shall be indicated in a future entry.
