

PROPOSED TARIFF PAGE AND CUSTOMER NOTICE**

On November 22, 2010 Aqua Ohio, Inc. ("Aqua") filed this Application to Assess and Collect a System Improvement Charge in its Lake Erie Division. On January 14, 2011 the Staff of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio filed their comments in the above-captioned proceeding.

However, the rates, effective May 25, 2007, for the Auburn Lakes Condominium Association, The Woods At Auburn Lakes and Auburn Crossings Condominium Unit Owners Association are governed by three individual agreements between those Associations and Aqua. 

CUSTOMER NOTICE: SYSTEM IMPROVEMENT CHARGE

Senate Bill 44, which became Ohio law on January 6, 2004, created an infrastructure improvement surcharge, known as the System Improvement Charge (SIC), to assist water companies to fund the replacement and rehabilitation of infrastructure including aging water mains that are crucial to service reliability and water quality. The surcharge may not exceed three (3%) percent per year.

With the Environmental Protection Agency estimating that approximately \$250 billion is needed to address water system infrastructure throughout the country over the next 20 years, SIC is important legislation which will allow water companies such as Aqua Ohio, Inc. to accelerate the replacement of old water mains to improve water quality, pressure, flow and long-term system viability. It transforms your infrastructure rehabilitation program from reactive to proactive and allows customers to pay as the work is being completed.

Aqua Ohio, Inc. filed an application on November 22, 2010 with the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (PUCO) in Case No. 10-____-WW-SIC seeking approval to assess and collect a SIC in its Lake Erie Division. The purpose of seeking authority to assess and collect a SIC in its Lake Erie Division is to recover costs related to certain qualifying infrastructure improvements, primarily water main replacements, to Aqua Ohio, Inc.'s distribution system. After conducting an investigation into the application, the PUCO approved Aqua Ohio, Inc.'s request on _____, 2011. The PUCO approved the assessment of a surcharge of three (3%) percent to your monthly bill. The surcharge will appear on billings on or after _____, 2011. The SIC approved by the PUCO will result in the average residential customer bill being increased by an additional charge in the amount of \$1.20 per month.

The surcharge will continue to appear on future bills and may be adjusted or eliminated based on the findings of the PUCO.
