#### COMPLAINT DESCRIPTION:

I own an all electric home and am writing to support reinstating the discount: Case No. 10-176-EL-ATA.

The following need to be done a9:10 PM 8/22/2010s a permanent solution regarding the all-electric home discount:

1.A permanent, all-electric rate differential on generation and distribution charges for nine months of the year for all-electric heating, load management, and water heating customers that stays with the property upon transfer to a new owner, including homes, apartments, and condos. The rate differential should be equivalent to the pre-2007 declining block structure.

2.The rate differential should be given to EVERY property, even those currently excluded because they were built or converted to all-electric after Jan 1, 2007.

3.Overcharges made by FirstEnergy between May 2009 and May 2010 should be refunded in full.

4.FirstEnergy must NOT raise the rates of other ratepayers, but rather absorb the cost of this program which benefited FirstEnergy for the last 30 years.

FirstEnergy made verbal and written promises to owners and builders alike to entice them to go all-electric, and they must not be allowed to break these promises and charge others for their breach of contract!

At the end of 2009 I owed a difference of \$500. My first bill in January, 2010 I owed a difference of \$300. In one month I owed a difference that was 60% of the entire previous 12 months.

Every two months I am making the equivalent of a mortgage payment that is going the the Electric company not my mortgage holder.

Without the above four actions taking place Ohio will have hundreds of thousands of homes that can not be sold because the high cost of electricity to all-electric homes. This will create another housing catastrophe.


Dear PUCO:

Your ruling to keep this discount is crucial to our daily lives. When I moved into Columbia Park in the Fall of 2005, I was made aware that those of us who used electricity exclusively were receiving this discount. That was one of the deciding factors in purchasing my home located at 12 Piccolo Place within the Park.

Please reconsider carefully the removal of this All Electric Home Discount since I am over 60 and on a very limited income it would be a great hardship to have to pay the higher rate. I don't want to have to apply for government assistance. I have been a full-time Realtor for 23 years. I have had many occasions to call the electric company serving Avon Lake for my customers to ask about the all-electric home discount rate. I had always, until 2009, been given the assurance that the rate discount would ALWAYS be in place for every owner of an all-electric home. In 2009 RE began to say that the discount was not applicable to buyers of all-electric homes but would stay in place for present owners who currently own their all-electric homes. Once again that was assurance that the home owner would always have their discounts if they owned before 2009.

As soon as I got word in 2009 that new owners would not receive the all-electric rate, buyers began to shy away from the all electric homes as soon as they learned of the situation. To RE's credit they began to quote the higher rates in 2009 to my buyers. Since then most buyers will not even "look" at all-electric homes. My considered professional opinion is that the lack of the all-electric discount has reduced the value of all-electric homes by \$20,000 to 25,000.

Being a trusting person I have never asked nor do I have any written materials from RE or The Illuminating company. A shame but I would certainly testify to the above stated facts.

I am also in an all-electric home and would like the discounted rate maintained. I have always been satisfied with the all-electric home but know that its value has decreased due to the uncertainty surrounding this whole issue. I plan to sign the petition from Mayor Zuber to bring a gas line into our neighborhood. This will be costly as the gas company will require I run at least one gas appliance off of their line. I am being forced to make this major modification to my home only because it will stabilize the value of my home.

I have analyzed SB 221 and find that it will be very destructive for Ohio and may be one reason Reliance Electric wants to remove the all-electric discounted rate.
