<u>ENTRY</u>

The attorney examiner finds:

- Rule 4901:5-3-01(A), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), requires each electric distribution utility and electric transmission owner to file annually a longterm forecast report (LTFR). On April 15, 2010, Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) filed its 2010 LTFR.
- (2) In accordance with Section 4935.04(D)(3), Revised Code, a public hearing was held in this matter on July 13, 2010. During the July 13, 2010 hearing, the attorney examiner granted the motions to intervene filed by the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) and the Ohio Environmental Council (OEC).
- (3) On January 14, 2011, a stipulation and recommendation was filed by DP&L, OCC, OEC, and Staff.
- (4) The attorney examiner finds that a hearing should be held in order to consider the stipulation filed by DP&L, OCC, OEC, and Staff. Accordingly, this matter should be set for hearing on March 8, 2011, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That a hearing in this matter be held on March 8, 2011, in accordance with finding (4). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
